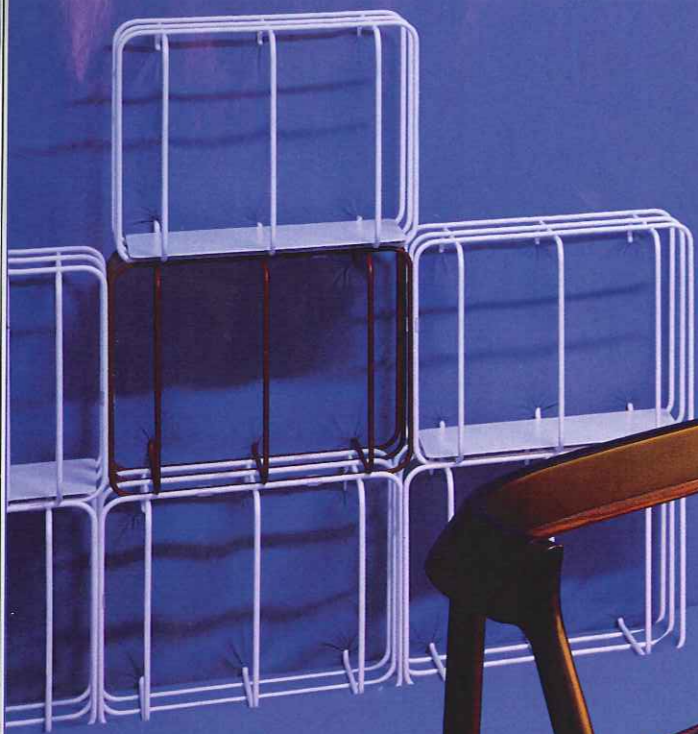
BEST NEW BEDS

All our bedroom fantasies have come true, with these sleek dreams

As we spend a third of our lives sleeping, it stands to reason that getting the right bed is crucial. These beds hit the mark not only in terms of their good looks (how could anyone not fall for the elegant simplicity of Noé Duchaufour-Lawrance's frame?), but also for their blend of comfort and practicality.

Giuseppe Viganò's 'Point', for example, has been a favourite since we first spotted its asymmetrical form at Bonaldo – the fins are perfect for your stash of pre-slumber reading material, while Arik Levy's 'Landscape' has storage recessed in the headboard. We're inclined to stage a permanent lie-in. ★

Winner of last year's Best Debut award (W\* 107), Wallpaper\* favourite Mater doesn't fail to impress. This year we are crowning it for this helmet-like lamp

### Best dining chair

Thanks to a beautiful teak frame and snug back rest and seat in leather, we certainly weren't going to sit on the fence when choosing the 'Coen' chair

### Best vases
